- You must read and understand the operators instruction manual and all other manuals associated with this machine. Different model machines or older/newer versions of the same model may have different parts and controls that you need to understand. If instructions are not readable or available DO NOT USE this machine and contact the factory for a replacement Manual.
- You must be able to physically handle the bulk weight and power of this machine. If not properly controlled this machine can cause death or serious injury.
- Do not operate this machine in an impaired mental state. You must be able to exercise good judgement and reactions to maintain a safe working environment.
- This is a "one person" machine which means only one operator can be operating the machine at any one time. For the safety of others, maintain a safe operating distance to other personnel. Your work area should be defined and appropriately marked so bystanders and coworkers do not stand or walk near this machine and end up seriously injured by flying debris or exposing them to harmful noise or dust.
